



DO YOU HAVE ANY HOLDS?

In UCDAccess, check for any holds that may affect your registration. If you have questions about a hold on your record, contact the office that has placed the hold. Ask your CLAS Academic Advisor if you aren't sure which office placed the hold. *Clear registration holds before your enrollment start date.*

FOLLOW THESE STEPS FOR ADVISING AND REGISTRATION

- 1 Review your Degree Audit in UCDAccess:** UCDAccess > ☰ > Degree Audit Tools > Degree Audit
If you don't have a Degree Audit, visit <http://ucdenver.navigate.eab.com/> or call 303-315-7100 to schedule a CLAS Advising appointment.
- 2 Work with your MAJOR/MINOR Advisors in your academic departments to plan out the major and minor coursework you need to satisfy program requirements.**
Find your faculty advisors on the CLAS Major & Minor Advisor Contact Information handout.
- 3 After you have reviewed your Degree Audit and planned out your major and minor coursework, work with your CLAS Academic Advisor to discuss any general degree requirement questions you have.** If you would like to set up an appointment to discuss your general degree requirements, use <http://ucdenver.navigate.eab.com/> or 303-315-7100 to make a CLAS Advising appointment.
- 4 Search for classes in UCDAccess and save courses that you want to take in your Shopping Cart.** This saves the classes so you can track how many seats are available and, when your specific date and time for registration comes, you can easily enroll in your chosen classes.
→ Your spring shopping cart opens in late October for you to prepare for registration.
→ Your summer shopping cart opens in late February for you to prepare for registration.
→ Your fall shopping cart opens beginning in late March for you to prepare for registration.
- 5 IMPORTANT: You must follow through to actually enroll in the classes in your Shopping Cart.** Clear any registration holds and enroll in your classes as soon as you can into get the best choice of classes.
Find your specific "Enrollment Date/Time" in UCDAccess:
UCDAccess > Student Center > Academics ➤ > Term Information > View my enrollment dates
● Spring enrollment dates show in late October ● Summer enrollment dates show in late February ● Fall enrollment dates show in late March
Note: Registration stays open from your designated time until the first week of classes in the term.
- 6 After you have completed enrollment for your classes, run a new Degree Audit to see where your registered courses fit** (registered courses take 10-20 minutes to show in the Degree Audit). Work with your CLAS Academic Advisor with any questions you have about your general degree requirements and discuss major and minor coursework details with your major/minor advisors. *For a CLAS Academic Advising appointment for general degree requirements, visit <http://ucdenver.navigate.eab.com/> or call 303-315-7100.*
