Different students prefer different styles of teaching and instructors may or may not be able to provide different methods of instruction based on their circumstances. You can use this grid to help in your planning but also understand that instructor's syllabus will be the final word on the structure of the course and as circumstances change, instructors may need to adapt their syllabus during the semester.
