- Students may transfer in up to 7 Communication classes (21 credits) from other schools.
- Of your 39 Communication credits, 15 must come from classes at 3000-level or above; no more than 56 credits can count toward the major.
- Grades of C- or better will count toward the major. Grades of B or better count for certificates.
- Honors = 3.0 overall and 3.5 GPA within major. COMM 4700 is required for high Latin honors and must be taken as a 16-week class in the final year, eligibility determined by GPA.
