**REMINDERS**

- 1) Students may be asked to make revisions by the exam committee. Be sure to **factor in time for revisions** when scheduling your exam/defense date rather than waiting until the deadline.
- 2) If any of the posted deadlines are missed, **graduation will be postponed to the next semester**. Students will be required to resubmit an application for graduation on their UCDAccess portal as it is not automatically deferred.
- 3) All forms should be **typed and signed electronically**.
- 4) Students **must be registered** in the semester in which they undertake comprehensive or final examinations as well as during the thesis, project, or dissertation defense.
- 5) Theses/dissertations should comply with the Format Guide **upon submission** for format review.
- 6) Transfer credit requests must be approved by the program and submitted **at least one semester prior** to the semester in which a master's student graduates or a doctoral student takes the comprehensive exam.
