### Why CU Succeed?

Students take CU Denver courses in their high schools, taught by CU Denver-approved teachers, at a reduced tuition rate. Students receive college credit with a letter grade on a CU Denver transcript!

**Cost:** CU Succeed classes are \$77 per credit hour. Tuition will be paid by the student, unless the school is paying on their behalf. Individual tuition rates are on the Course Offerings List.

**Credits:** These CU Denver credits apply to degree programs at CU Denver, and may be transferred to other colleges and universities.

**Important information:** Enrollment for CU Denver credit is optional. You must register by the deadline to get college credit.

**Parents:** Your student will be considered a CU Denver student and will be subject to FERPA privacy laws, regardless of age. Much of their information cannot be shared with you without their permission. Please visit our Parent Information web page for a more details.

### Spring 2026 Deadlines

Registration Opens: January 6th  
Registration Closes: February 8th  
Parent Financial Forms Due: February 17th  
Drop Date: March 27th\*  
Withdraw Date: April 3rd  
Tuition Due: February 28th\*\*

\*courses must be dropped with CU. Dropping at your high school will not remove the course from your CU transcript, and tuition will still be due.

\*\*This is the earliest tuition will be due. Check your CU Student Portal (UCDAccess) for your individual due date.
