Invitational Summer Institute (ISI)

The 2022 ISI will meet *in-person on the Auraria Campus in Denver* from June 6th – June 24th Monday - Friday from 9 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

There is a pre-institute meeting on Saturday, April 23rd from 10am – 12pm and a post-institute meeting on Saturday, October 1st from 10am – 12pm. Both meetings will be held in-person on the Auraria Campus. Before applying, please confirm that your schedule allows you to attend all meetings.

Those accepted into our program can earn up to six graduate credits towards an M.A. in English or Education at CU Denver and/or a certificate proving 120 hours of professional development. We encourage all participants to take advantage of the opportunity to earn graduate credit.

Those accepted will also earn a \$200 stipend. Those who elect to enroll and pay for 3 graduate credit hours will receive a \$400 stipend and those who elect to enroll and pay for 6 graduate credit hours will receive a \$600 stipend to offset tuition costs.

Eligibility

Classroom teacher at a public or private school, K-16, any discipline, professional commitment to the teaching of writing and related literacy activities, and personal commitment to developing as a writer.

Requirements Send:

- 1. In a personal statement, please address the following:
 - Why are you applying at this point in your career?
 - What do you enjoy about teaching writing, or/and what is a core belief that you possess about the teaching of writing? (We believe all teachers, every grade, every discipline, are *teachers of writing*).
 - As a result of participating in the Denver Writing Project ISI, how are you hoping to grow as a teacher of writing? As a writer yourself?
