Dr. Hampanda is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus. She also serves as the Associate Director of Research for the Division of Academic Specialists in Ob/Gyn. Promoting HIV Health Behaviors Among Pregnant Couples in Zambia Using an Adaptive Relationship Strengthening Intervention

In a randomized controlled trial, this study will test a couples counseling intervention focused on strengthening relationships for HIV-positive pregnant women and their male partners in Zambia to promote HIV care and treatment and PMTCT outcomes, including postpartum viral suppression (primary outcome), and ascertain underlying mechanisms. The intervention has the potential to significantly reduce the burden of disease among families affected by HIV.
