University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus Research Program in Environmental Health Sciences

- **Paid year-long** research and mentorship opportunity in Environmental Health Sciences at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus
- Specifically for Sophomore to Senior level undergraduate science majors from an *underrepresented minority population, with disabilities or disadvantaged background*
- Includes full summer research and mentorship program (40 hrs/week) and a school year research opportunity (10 hrs/week) - \$15/hr
- Research opportunities include: biomonitoring of environmental exposures, genetics of environmental lung disease, environmental justice projects, immunology, nanomaterial safety, wildfire particle toxicology, environmental causes of cancer, effects of inhaled pollutants, traumatic brain injury, liver toxicology and effects of ethanol as examples.
- Program includes mentoring on careers in environmental health, applying to graduate or professional schools, responsible conduct in research training, research retreat and social activities

Applications due April 1, 2023 Program begins May 30th, 2023
