The Tribal Health Experiential Student Internship Seminar program (THESIS) is a virtual 8-week (May 22nd- July 24th) paid internship for undergrad and recently graduated college students interested in Native American health. Intern Stipend

Each intern will be provided with a stipend up to \$3,360.



Learning Management System

Canvas will be utilized for courses and all course information. Canvas training will be provided for all participants, both mentors and mentees.



Mentor Contact

Throughout the internship, the mentee will be required to complete weekly check-in's with their mentor via the chosen form of communication such as email, Zoom, phone, etc.
