

Mark Foster History Scholarship

Scholarship Information

This scholarship was established by Professor Emeritus Mark S. Foster, a distinguished teacher, accomplished scholar, and esteemed colleague, who wished to encourage students at CU Denver to pursue the study of History. Each year, the department plans to award the scholarship to at least one undergraduate History major who demonstrates outstanding academic achievement as well as financial need. Awardees will receive \$1000 toward their tuition.

Eligibility & criteria:

- This scholarship is open to undergraduate History majors who have completed **at least six** History credits at CU Denver.
- Applicants will be evaluated based on academic merit and financial need.
- The department especially welcomes applications from first-generation college students and students from historically underrepresented populations.

Deadline & how to apply:

- All application materials must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 3, 2018.
