B.A. Degree Requirements History Major/Minor

Undergraduate Major (36 Credits)

For the BA in history, students must complete a minimum of 36 credit hours of history coursework, with at least 18 history hours taken at the University of Colorado Denver. Additionally, majors must have at least 18 upper division (3000 and 4000) history credit hours, **of which 15 must be taken at the 4000 level including HIST 4839, the History Seminar.** Not more than 56 hours of history will be counted toward graduation requirements. A student needs a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better in the major to graduate, and no grade lower than a C- will count toward the major requirements.

Undergraduate Minor (18 Credits)

Students interested in a history minor are required to complete 18 hours of coursework with at least a 2.5 grade point average. No grade of lower than a C- will count toward the minor requirements. The History Department encourages students to take History 3031, Theory and Practice of History, as an elective, but it is not required. In addition, a minimum of 3 credit hours is required in each of the following areas: United States, Europe, and World (Asia, Africa, and Latin America). Students must choose at least 9 hours of elective upper-division (3000- and 4000-level) history credits. At least 12 credit hours must be completed at UCD.
