

# STUDENT JOB CODE DEFINITIONS

### STUDENT FACULTY (1500 JOB CODE SERIES):

### **TEACHING** (must be paid monthly on contract)

- **1503 Graduate Part-Time Instructor (GPTI):** This title is used for enrolled, advanced degree students who hold a *master's degree* or its equivalent, and who have demonstrated competence in classroom teaching. Generally, GPTIs are given responsibility for a class or classes at the undergraduate level.
- **1506 Graduate Teaching Assistant** (*Teaching Assistant in HCM*): **Enrolled** *graduate* students assisting in classroom or laboratory *instructional activities*. We have 2 types of TAs in CLAS: TAs who teach a lower-level course under the supervision of a qualification faculty member, and TAs to assist a primary faculty member and/or lead a recitation or lab.
- **1508 Undergraduate Teaching Assistant**): **Enrolled upper division** <u>undergraduate</u> students assisting in classroom or laboratory instruction, grading examinations or term papers, or otherwise assisting in the department instructional activities.

"Instructional activities" are defined as any combination of lab set-up and preparation, conducting tests and/or experiments, lab/class instruction, course development, grading, etc.

### **GRADER** (must be paid hourly)

**1504 – Grader** (*Reader in HCM*): This title is used to designate enrolled graduate degree students or upper division undergraduate students engaged in positions where the **sole purpose** is to **grade** tests, term papers, homework, essays, etc.

## <u>RESEARCH</u> (must be funded by externally sponsored research or start-up accounts; can be paid hourly or monthly)

**1505 – Graduate Research Assistant** (Research Assistant in HCM): **Enrolled** <u>graduate</u> students who assist with and are engaged in <u>research activities</u> and are not involved in instruction.

**1507 – Undergraduate Research Assistant**): **Enrolled upper division** <u>undergraduate</u> students who assist with and are engaged in **research activities**.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE** (must be paid hourly)

**1502 – Graduate Assistant**: **Enrolled** *graduate* students who have assignments in the department but are not involved directly in instruction.

### STUDENT ASSISTANTS (4100 JOB CODE SERIES):

**Student Assistant I-VI:** Examples of work performed or positions in this series may include: filing, reception, sorting and routing mail, typing, word processing, clerical/office/staff assistant, data entry operator, computer operator, clerk typist, administrative assistant, computer programmer, web page administration; computer lab monitoring. Refer to the Student Employment Handbook for specific job class descriptions.

#### **High/Trade School/Other**

**4301 – Non-CU Student:** This job class describes a student from a high school, trade school, non-CU higher education institution, or other school (as defined by each campus) who is working for the University of Colorado.
