## University of Colorado Anschutz Research Program in Environmental Health Sciences

- **Paid year-long** research and mentorship opportunity in Environmental Health Sciences at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus
- Specifically for Sophomore to Senior level undergraduate science majors
- Includes full summer research and mentorship program (**40 hrs/week**) and a school year research opportunity (10 hrs/week) - \$19.29/hr
- Research opportunities include: biomonitoring of environmental exposures, genetics of environmental lung disease, chemical threat weapons, projects working with communities with environmental concerns, immunotoxicology, nanomaterial safety, wildfire particle toxicology, environmental causes of cancer, effects of inhaled pollutants, traumatic brain injury, liver toxicology and effects of ethanol as examples.
- Program includes mentoring on careers in environmental health, a research project with a potential to publish, applying to graduate or professional schools, responsible conduct in research training, research retreat and social activities
