

Tutor Positions at the Math and Stat Tutoring Center

Description

The Math and Stat Tutoring Center operates Monday – Friday in the Learning Commons (1191 Larimer Street) and offers free drop-in assistance to CU Denver students enrolled in a mathematics course. Our tutors are responsible for assisting students with their mathematical needs both individually and in small groups.

For Spring, Summer and Fall 2026, undergraduate tutors are hired at \$19.29/hour and graduate tutors start at \$22.00/hour. Typical shifts are 2-3 hours in length and we encourage our tutors to work at least two days each week.

Requirements:

- Tutor appointments are reserved for CU Denver students actively enrolled and participating in an approved undergraduate or graduate program.
- Ideal Tutors have completed both Linear Algebra and Calculus III.
- Applicants will be subject to a background check prior to hiring.

Important Notes on Employment:

Students may work a maximum of 25 hours per week or 50 hours total per biweekly payroll period during the fall and spring semesters, provided that no single week in that period exceeds 40 hours. International students may work a maximum of 20 hours per week. Work hour limits apply to all positions held at CU combined. You must disclose to your employing department any other employment you have with the University of Colorado.
