Students must be registered at the time they undertake the comprehensive or final examinations as well as during their thesis or dissertation defense.

Reminder to Thesis/Dissertation Candidates:

Your thesis/dissertation must comply with the <u>Style and Policy Manual</u> upon submission for format review.

Reminders to Candidates:

- Transfer credit requests must be approved by the program and submitted to the Graduate School before the semester in which a student defends/graduates. Transfer of credit requests that are submitted in the last semester cannot be listed on the Application to Candidacy and will not count toward graduation credits.
- To complete the application for candidacy, print a copy of your unofficial transcript and refer to it as you complete your Application for Candidacy. Please only include courses that count directly toward your degree. Do not include any failed classes or any classes you were enrolled in that are not required/permitted for your degree. The number of credits indicated on the first page of the Application for Candidacy Form (confirmed by your program) should be the minimum number of credits that are required for graduation, not the total of number of credits you have earned.
