#### LATN 3000 Medical Terminology

Sec. E01 Online

The course enables students to understand medical terms by learning the Greek and Latin word elements that form these terms.

### SPAN 1000 Intro to Cultures of the Spanish Speaking World

Sec. E01 Online L. Thorton Introduces students to the Spanish-speaking cultures of Spain, Latin America, and the United States through a historical overview and a focus on contemporary politics and culture. Note: Taught in English. Denver Core Curriculum: Humanities

## SPAN 1010 Beginning Spanish I

Sec. E01 Online

Introduces basic Spanish pronunciation and grammar, useful vocabulary and idioms. Readings and class discussions relating to the Hispanic world. Prereq: Students must complete this course with a grade of "C" or better to continue on to SPAN 1020.

#### SPAN 1020 Beginning Spanish II

Online

Sec. E01

(Continuation of SPAN 1010). Further development of listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. Prereq: SPAN 1010 with grade of "C" (2.0) or better (or equivalent).

#### SPAN 2110 Second Year Spanish I

#### Sec. 001 Online

Continues the development of skills acquired in 1010 and 1020. Readings deal with Hispanic culture and current topics from Spain and Latin America. Development of informal oral and written expression.

#### SPAN 4076/5076 Spanish in Colorado

## Sec. 001 Online

#### Five-week Intensive Course June 4, 2018 – July 7, 2018

A study of the Spanish language in its social context in Colorado and New Mexico. We will study historical factors as well as current social factors that contribute to the use of the Spanish language in this region. Prereq: SPAN 3060.
