He or she must have enrolled and completed the course MLNG 5690 "Methods of Teaching Modern Languages," during the fall semester, or demonstrate previous teaching excellence in college-level Spanish courses.

## **Application Deadlines**

For the fall semester – March  $1^{th}$ For the spring semester – Oct  $1^{th}$ 

The Department of Modern Languages now offers a Teaching Assistantship Scholarship. This scholarship is open to all students who are currently enrolled in the Spanish MA program and teaching a Spanish course as a Teaching Assistant. It provides a partial-tuition scholarship, equivalent to a 3-credit hour graduate course in the same semester that the TA is teaching, in addition to the monthly TA stipend.

- Awarded to both new and continuing TAs through a competitive-based application process.
- Up to four scholarships will be awarded during any given semester.
- May be renewable for up to 4 semesters and requires participants to meet and maintain all University academic standards

## Eligibility

- Must be a Graduate student in the MA in Spanish program, teaching a Spanish course as a TA.
- Must have a graduate cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. In the absence of graduate coursework, students must show an undergraduate total cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher, with a Spanish cumulative GPA of 3.6.
- Application and resume/cv required.
