PROGRAM FEATURES

Study at the Universidad de Valladolid, founded in the early 13th century by Alfonso VIII, King of Castile. In addition to providing intensive practice in all four language skills in Spanish, this program introduces students to the various facets of contemporary life in Spain as a means of gaining a basic understanding of past and present Spanish society.

While in Valladolid, students will live in a homestay with a native family.

Guided excursions on evenings and weekends to historical and scenic places, including Ávila, Burgos, Santander, San Sebastián & Madrid.
