Dear Colorado National Qualifiers!

Congrats on qualifying for the National NHD contest! The National Contest is held on the campus of the University of Maryland from June 8th to 13th, 2025. Now that you have made it to Nationals, you must know their deadlines and book your transportation and boarding ASAP. Colorado and the National office are not responsible for this next step; your family is responsible for all fees and the trip, which includes booking lodging, getting to Maryland, registering for the National Contest by May 10th, uploading your project, meeting the due dates, and paying all fees by the due dates. Try to stay in the University dorms on campus, they are much cheaper than D.C. area hotels. There are no late registrations or payments, this is the National Contest expectation. Once you receive a welcome email, you can find all the information you need on the National ZFairs platform. Please, do not create a new account; you are to use the same account that you used for the regional and state NHDC contests. Know your username and passwords. National Qualifiers and their family need to READ through ALL materials, every line and every page, to familiarize themselves with expectations.

Please note, you are required to bring your T-shirt that you were given at the State NHDC contest to the National contest to wear to the Capitol on June 11th and in the Parade of States event on June 12th. Please do not forget your T-shirt! You will be given a bag of buttons before you leave for the National Contest; that bag of buttons is to come to the National Contest with you; you will need it for the Opening Ceremony on June 8th.

The Colorado delegation will have some fun events that each of you will be able to attend. You must reserve your spot at some of the events. Reservations for these events will open on May 19, 2025. A link will be sent to all National Qualifiers via their email.

Event #1: June 8th- Colorado Welcome Party- I will meet the entire Colorado delegation, family included, in the Baltimore Room at the Stamp Student Union for a welcome party that includes pizza and ice cream. Please plan to attend this event with a guardian. We will be taking pictures and giving out important information. After our party, we will head directly over to the Opening Ceremony and sit together.

Event #2: June 10th- We will travel to Mount Vernon and visit the plantation owned by President George Washington. This is available to only 14 people who can travel via a private charter that day with me. We will be meeting at the Stamp Student Union at 11 am and will not return until 6 pm. The cost of this experience is \$20.00 per person. First, you will register via a Google form, and then I will reach out to each person via email for payment. This event is limited to 2 people per family, with priority given to students who are part of the Colorado delegation. Additional delegation members who rented a car can meet us at Mount Vernon at our arrival time, and I will provide an entry ticket for you.

Event #3: June 11th: Morning Capitol Visit with CO Senators Bennet and Hickenlooper and a tour of the Capitol by their staff. We will take the metro into Washington, D.C from the Green Line at the University of Maryland. We will visit the CO Senators and then do a tour inside the Capitol. You will have an opportunity to visit the Smithsonian afterward if you wish or walk to the monuments on the National Mall. The CO State office will be supplying each student and teacher with a one-day metro pass. You should wear comfortable shoes and your NHD T-shirt to this event. This is limited to the first 70 people, with priority given to students and teachers who are part of the Colorado delegation. If additional members of families would like to attend, they are responsible for purchasing their metro pass. Due to the secure nature and access we are being granted, Dr. Cvanciger will turn away any person who shows up with items prohibited in the Capitol, including water bottles, backpacks, suitcases, etc. We will be on our best behavior and listen to everything we are told to do. It is best to bring nothing but your phone, wallet, and any medical needs.

Event #4: June 12th: Parade of States- University of Maryland Xfinity Center. The entire CO delegation will wear their state contest T-shirts and attend the Parade of States before the 2025 NHD Awards Ceremony. Lots of pictures will be taken at this event!

NHD LODGING AND MEAL PACKAGES 2025

These packages are for those wishing to stay in the dorms on campus or purchase an on-campus meal plan at the University of Maryland, College Park. Dorm packages include housing, bed linens (1 blanket, 2 flat sheets, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, 2 towels), and a meal plan. Dorm rooms will have two people in each room. You may select a roommate if you prefer, or one may be selected for you. More information is available in registration to help you with roommate requests and health conditions when you sign up for a dorm package. **Please note:** All students staying in dorms **MUST** have a chaperone with them who is also staying in the dorms.

Meal Times: Breakfast 7:00 - 9:00 a.m., Lunch 11:30 - 1:30 p.m., Dinner 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

- For meals on Wednesday (6/11), the deadline is Sunday, June 8.




