The attack on Pearl Harbor [lab 4] was a surprise military strike conducted by the Imperial Japanese Navy against the United States naval base at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, on the morning of December 7, 1941 (December 8 in Japan). The attack led to the United States' entry into World War II.

The attack was intended as a <u>preventive</u> action in order to keep the <u>U.S. Pacific Fleet</u> from interfering with military actions the <u>Empire of Japan</u> was planning in <u>Southeast Asia</u> against overseas territories of the <u>United Kingdom</u>, the <u>Netherlands</u>, and the <u>United States</u>. There were simultaneous Japanese attacks on the <u>U.S.-held Philippines</u> and on the <u>British Empire</u> in <u>Malaya</u>, <u>Singapore</u>, and <u>Hong Kong</u>.
