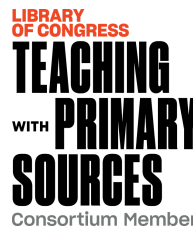

Dear Prospective NHD Educator,

Hello, in the summer of 2024, National History Day-Colorado is offering a Teacher Institute, July 25-27th. This is an on-site-expenses paid, 3-day institute designed for educators to learn how to implement the NHD curriculum in their classroom. This amazing opportunity is co-sponsored by prominent organizations that support the study of history. This includes the History Colorado Center, the University of Colorado Department of History, Teaching with Primary Sources at MSU, the Denver Public Library, the Molly Brown House, and the Center for Colorado Women's History.

As part of this incredible opportunity, teachers will come to the University of Colorado, Denver campus, to learn the ins and outs of creating NHD projects, agreeing to bring project-based learning to their classroom in the 2024-2025 academic year. Educators will receive a double-occupancy dorm/hotel room, meals, museum admission, and NHD resources during the three-day institute. In return for this \$2,000 in-kind award, teachers will implement the NHD curriculum in their classroom during the 2025 contest cycle and agree to compete with their students in a NHDC regional contest. To apply, teachers will fill out the attached google form and sign the agreement. A letter of recommendation from your school principal is required upon submission. National History Day-Colorado will select up to 40 educators from around the state to participate in the program. The application for this opportunity opens May 8th and closes June 1st, 2024. Teachers will be notified by June 7th if they qualify for the program.
