

Preparing to Register

Who MUST Complete Contest Registration:

- Teachers of competing students
- Competing students, accompanied by their parents or guardians

Please note: ALL students in a group entry must register and pay registration fees for an entry to be evaluated.

NECESSARY INFORMATION FOR REGISTRATION

ALL registrants must provide the following:

- Telephone Number
- Mailing Address (Address to receive certificate and any medals/awards after contest)
- Email Address (NHD staff will use your email address to contact you after the contest.)

Students must provide these additional items:

- Teacher Name and School
- Entry Category, Division, Title
- Credit Card Number (if applicable)

REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE PROMPTLY AT <u>11:59 PM ET ON TUESDAY, MAY</u> <u>17, 2022.</u>

Registrants who do not complete the payment before the 11:59 p.m. ET Tuesday, May 17 deadline will face a \$50 Late Fee. The late fee will increase to \$60 on Thursday, May 19. If payment is not completed by Friday, May 22, the late fee will increase to \$75. If you need to complete your payment after the May 17 deadline, you must contact the NHD National Office. Registration FAQs

When Can You Register?

You will be able to register for the National Contest only after the completion of your affiliate contest. You will receive an email from zFairs.com notifying you when registration is open for your affiliate. If you have not received any notification several business days after your contest, please contact your affiliate coordinator. You can find your coordinator's contact information on the NHD website: NHD.org/Affiliate.

Why Do You Need Parent/Guardian Information?

Parents/guardians are expected to assist their child in completing the registration process. This includes agreeing to authorizations within the system. Each student will need to list at least one parent/guardian in their registration. Parents/guardians should **not** create a separate account.

How Do You Register Group Projects?

If you are registering a group project, each person in your group must register individually. However, only one member of your group will enter the project information. Once project information is submitted, the student who created the entry will inform group members of the **Team Key** (e.g., b965f631-a8a0-4eff-8145-d1698f3618d3). For detailed instructions on group projects, see instructions on page 7. *Please note:* All group members must complete registration and payment for an entry to be evaluated.

How Do You Nominate Your Entry for a Special Award?

A number of organizations sponsor prizes awarded to the entry that best exemplifies the specific prize criteria. Special prizes are topic-specific. To see if your entry is eligible, browse the list on the NHD website, NHD.org/Special-Prizes. To nominate your entry, you must first complete your student registration and payment. On the registration confirmation page, you will see a blue **Special Award Nominations** button that will take you to the nomination screen. Or you can log back into your account and click on your name in the top right corner, and choose **My Profile**. Then click the **Special Awards Nominations** tab. Find the special awards that interest you and click the **Nominate** button below the award. You may nominate your entry for up to two awards **only**. In the nomination, please include a short statement about how your project meets the prize criteria and why it should be considered.

How Do You Receive Emails from the Registration System?

You need to accept emails from <u>zFairs.com</u> to receive the system's automatic email messages. If you do not receive a message, check your email spam folder. If you are using a school email address, check with your IT department to make sure you can receive outside messages and request that emails coming from zFairs.com be approved to be received, or "whitelisted." If possible, please do not use a school email address.

Creating a Student Account (Students in CA, CO, American Samoa, NHD China)

After your teacher(s) create their accounts, follow the steps below to begin registration.

- Use the National Contest private registration link to access the registration homepage. This will be sent from **zFairs.com** and/or your affiliate coordinator.
- Click Create Account in the toolbar, then select Student from the drop-down menu.
- Insert your first name, last name, and email address. Click the checkbox next to I am Not a
 Robot. Then, click the Save & Continue button. Please Note: This is the email contest
 coordinators will use to contact you. We may not be able to contact you via school email.
- Complete the **Student's Personal Information** section. In this section you will be asked to upload a profile photo. This photo is optional and may be used in the Welcome and/or Awards Ceremony. Then, click the **Save & Continue** button.
- Complete the **Additional Questions** section. Then, click the **Save & Continue** button.
- Add your School, Teacher, and Grade information. Then, click the Save & Continue button.
- Complete the **Entry** section.
 - Group Projects Only
 - IF YOU ARE REGISTERING AS PART OF A GROUP PROJECT The first student in a group to register will create the entry. That student will give other group members the Team/Project Key. This Team/Project Key will appear in a confirmation screen for the first student, as well as in that student's profile when logged into the account. Sample Team/Project Key: b965f631-a8a0-4eff-8145-d1698f3618d3.
 - The other group members will create their student accounts and enter the Team/Project Key for their entry. This will bring up the title and description for their entry that was filled out by the group member who created the entry.
- The Entry section includes writing a Project Description. In the description, briefly summarize
 the historical argument and content of your project. Upload your project on this page. You can
 do it during registration or log back in later and upload an updated version before the May 17
 at 11:59 p.m. ET. registration deadline. See page 16 for information on how to format and
 submit your project. Then, click the Save & Continue button.
- On the next page, review the Special Prizes. You can nominate your project for <u>two</u> special prizes. You can do this now or log back in later and nominate your project. Then, click the Save & Continue button.
- Complete the **Student Permissions and Waivers** section with a parent/guardian. Then, click the **Save & Continue** button.
- On the Payment page, select credit/debit card payment, invoice, or that your school is paying.

Creating a Teacher Account (Teachers in CA, CO, American Samoa, NHD China) Teachers need to register <u>before</u> their students can begin to register. Follow the steps below to begin registration.

- Go to the National Contest registration homepage: National.NHD.Org
- Click Create Account in the toolbar, then select Teacher from the drop-down menu.
- Insert your first name, last name, and email address. Click the checkbox next to I am Not a Robot. Then, click the blue Next button.
- Complete the **Teacher's Personal Information** section. This includes uploading a profile photo. This photo is optional and may be used in the Awards Ceremony. Then, click the blue **Next** button.

Checking Your Students' Registration Progress

- After logging in to your teacher account, click My Students in the top toolbar.
- This page lists each of your students. Click on a name to bring up a pop-up menu. You can Edit/View Participant profile (this includes uploading project PDFs or links), change
 - Password/Username, Link/Unlink projects, and Email Participants.
- Please note: Checking student profiles can only be done before contest registration closes on May 17, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. ET.

Registration Symbol Key

Under My Students, each student has a series of icons next to their name/entry:



- A dollar bill: The color of the symbol (red or green) shows whether the student's registration fee is paid. Green means it is paid.
- A map: If you hover over the map it will show you which affiliate the student is registered under.
- **An arrow:** This symbol will only appear if the student has been promoted into the contest. Students are only promoted if the previous contest uses zFairs and has advanced winners.
- Conversation Bubble with Check Mark: This icon will appear if the student has agreed to the permissions and waivers as part of registration.
- **Piece of Paper**: This symbol will only appear if the student's registration fee payment is on an invoice that they created or that their teacher created. If students paid by credit card, this symbol will not appear.
- No Team Members: This symbol will only appear if a student registered as a group project but they do not have other group members linked to their group. If this appears, please contact Registration@NHD.Org to link students to their group members.

Registration Fees

Student Contest Fees: Each student must pay the \$150 student registration fee for the contest. Teachers can process all contest registration payments for their students at once. PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR TEACHER TO FIND OUT HOW YOU SHOULD PROCEED WITH PAYMENT. Otherwise, you must use a credit card to pay online or indicate that you intend to mail a check for the full amount. Please note: There is no Teacher Registration Fee for the 2022 National Contest.

Submitting Payment: Individual fees cannot be split between multiple forms of payment (i.e., credit card and check). Each order must be paid in full by a single form of payment. For example, if your Student Registration Fees are being paid by a check from your school, the check must cover the full amount (\$150) of your Student Registration Fee. *Please note: If your NHD Affiliate program is paying for any of your fees, please follow the instructions from them on how to process your payment.*

 - Either enter credit card information or print the invoice to mail with a check to complete payment.

- If you need to insert payment information later, login and click your name in the top right corner.
- Select My Profile from the drop-down menu and then click the Store tab in your toolbar. Add the
 Student Registration Fee to your cart, and select Card to pay with a credit card, Check to pay by
 check, or School to signify that your school is paying your fee. PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR
 TEACHER FIRST BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH PAYMENT. Please note: Credit card payments

- All of your students will appear in the list. Check the box next to the student(s) for whom you are paying.
- Add the fees to the cart.
- · Click the blue Checkout & Pay button.
- If you are paying by credit card, select Pay Online.
 - · Complete the required fields.
 - · Click Pay Now.
- If you are paying by check, select **Generate Invoice**.
 - Confirm the information is accurate and print this invoice.
 - Present this invoice to your school or paying organization's finance office to obtain the check.
 - Mail the invoice along with the check, as instructed.
 - Please note: If your NHD Affiliate program is paying for any of your fees, please follow the instructions from them on how to process your payment.
