## CU SUCCEED

High School students completing a National History Day project can receive 3 college credits (History 1400) in cooperation with CU Denver CU Succeed program. This asynchronous class runs every October to May.

The elementary poster is specifically designed to prepare students for History Day. The projects must include a Colorado history topic that fits the annual theme.
