

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum grade of C is required in each course.
- A total of 36 semester hours must be completed for the philosophy major, at least 18 of which must be taken at CU Denver.
- For those students who qualify for and fulfill the requirements of graduation with Honors, a total of at least 39 hours is required.
- Courses taken at other institutions must be approved by an advisor in the Philosophy Department for application towards the major. No more than 6 hours below the 3000 level may be counted toward the major.


