



Philosophy MAJOR

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ A minimum grade of C is required in each course.
- ✓ A total of **36 semester hours** must be completed for the philosophy major, **at least 18** of which must be taken at CU Denver.
- ✓ For those students who qualify for and fulfill the requirements of graduation with Honors, a total of at least 39 hours is required.
- ✓ Courses taken at other institutions must be approved by an advisor in the Philosophy Department for application towards the major. No more than 6 hours below the 3000 level may be counted toward the major.
