



PHILOSOPHY DEPARTMENT GET AN EDGE WITH ETHICS APPLICATION

Scholarship Information

The Department of Philosophy is pleased to offer up to 3 scholarships each academic year for undergraduate students at the University of Colorado Denver. Recipients will receive \$400 to underwrite their enrollment in an ethics class in philosophy.

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage students to take an ethics course and to consider pursuing an ethics certificate and/or pursuing a major or minor in philosophy.

Eligibility and criteria:

- Scholarship recipient must be enrolled in the ethics course for which the funding will be used by the start of the semester of the award and remain enrolled until the end. The award can be applied to either Lower or Upper division ethics courses
- Awards are only available for Fall or Spring semester.
- Scholarship recipient must be enrolled in the ethics course for which the funding will be used by the start of the semester of the award and remain enrolled until the end. The award can be applied to either Lower or Upper division ethics courses.
- Eligible students must have at least a CU Denver 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Eligible students must have completed at least one PHIL ethics course (introductory or otherwise) that could count toward an Ethics Certificate or the Ethics Minor.
- To apply students must submit the following application along with a paragraph-long personal statement including which ethics course(s) they have taken previously and describing why they are interested in taking another ethics course.
- Applications are due on or before the 15th of November for Spring semester awards and on or before the 15th of May for Fall semester.
- Applicants must send their applications to our program assistant, John Brogan john.brogan@ucdenver.edu.
The scholarship application and statement must be submitted as a single PDF file using the following file name: GET AN EDGE_LastName, FirstName_

Decisions will be made by the end of Fall Semester for Spring semester and by the end of May for Fall semester. The Department of Philosophy reserves the right not to award a scholarship for any given semester should the evaluating committee judge that no applications merit it.

Please note: Scholarship recipients may, if they wish, apply again for this scholarship for a different semester than the one already awarded. However, priority will be given to students who would be first time recipients of the award.
