## Sample Curriculum for Students Entering the CHP Program in an Even Year

- <u>Yoked Courses</u>. Some courses in the CHP PhD program are offered in alternating years. When students take those courses depends on whether they entered the program in the fall of an even or an odd numbered year.
- <u>Electives.</u> Students take two electives during their time in the program. When electives are taken is at the students' decision. Electives appear in the sample curricula as examples of when they might be taken.

All courses are 3 credits unless otherwise noted. In addition to the minimum required 63 credits of coursework, students must also register for a minimum of 26 clinical practicum hours, 4 credits of thesis and 6 credits of doctoral dissertation. In addition, students will register for 3 credits of pre-doctoral internship each of the three semesters of their internship year for a total of 108 credits. Students can complete the program in five years and have up to eight years according to graduate school rules. \*This course is not required to complete the PhD program but it is required to independently teach a course. It is likely that at some point in students' careers in the program their funding will depend on being able to independently teach a course.
