Courses are 3 units unless otherwise noted. 99 units are taken: 60 coursework, 26 clinical practicum, 4 thesis, 6 dissertation and 3 internship (1 unit in each of the 3 semesters of internship year). Some courses are offered in alternating years or every other year so when they are taken depends on if a student entered the program in an even or odd numbered year. Sample curricula are provided for each scenario. Two electives are taken; the program offers Group Interventions in Health Psychology, Cardiovascular Health and Psychopharmacology. Outside elective(s) can be taken with the approval of the Program Director. The program can be completed in 5 years but 6 years is the mean, median and mode for completion for programs of this sort. The Graduate School allows 8 years for completion of graduate programs.
