

## **Guided Questions for Peer Review**

Issue	Guided Questions
Thesis Statement	<ul> <li>How is the thesis structured? Does it follow the teacher's instructions?</li> <li>How can the thesis be more specific and complex?</li> <li>How can the writer demonstrate why their argument is significant?</li> <li>Does the thesis provide an outline of where the paper goes?</li> </ul>
Organization	<ul> <li>How do the ideas in the paper progress?</li> <li>How does the writer transition between points and/or paragraphs?</li> <li>Does the writer use paragraphs that are too short? How can the writer develop the paragraph more or integrate this information elsewhere?</li> <li>Does the writer use paragraphs that are too long? How can the writer condense these paragraphs or split them up?</li> </ul>
Evidence & Analysis	<ul> <li>Is every piece of evidence followed by analysis?</li> <li>Where can the analysis better explain the evidence?</li> <li>How often does the writer use quotations? Where can the writer paraphrase instead?</li> <li>Is it clear how examples support the argument and connect to the thesis?</li> <li>Does the writer make any leaps in judgment that are questionable or illogical?</li> <li>Where can the writer incorporate a counterargument?</li> </ul>
Citation	<ul> <li>What citation style should the writer be using? Is the writer following this style?</li> <li>Does the writer cite everything that comes from an outside source? Are any in-text citations missing?</li> </ul>
Introduction	<ul> <li>How does the introduction hook the reader?</li> <li>Does the introduction provide enough context on the paper's topic?</li> <li>Does the introduction use clichés (such as rhetorical questions or dictionary definitions)?</li> </ul>
Conclusion	<ul> <li>Does the conclusion introduce new information?</li> <li>How can the conclusion restate the thesis in a more complex way?</li> <li>Does the conclusion summarize the main points of the paper?</li> <li>How does the conclusion reinforce the significance of the writer's argument?</li> </ul>
